Salon Two Nine to Share Grand Opening Proceeds with JDRF Illinois

Individuals with Type 1 diabetes cannot produce insulin, which is used by the body to turn glucose in the blood into energy. Without insulin, glucose causes high blood sugar, or hyperglycemia, which can create additional health problems.

The 25-year old Rosenwinkel was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes just four months ago when extremely high blood sugar caused vision problems.
